Tea is made by steeping processed leaves; buds or twigs of the tea bush *Camellia sinensis* in hot water. The processing can include oxidation, heating, drying and the addition of other herbs, flowers, spices and fruit. The four basic and best known types of true tea are black tea, white tea, green tea and oolong tea.

Black Tea

Black tea is fully fermented, which means more oxidised than the green, oolong and white varieties. This makes it a lot more intense in its flavour.

Earl Grey 'Blue'

A precious black tea infused with bergamot oil with added blue and purple cornflowers

Royal Automobile Club Original

A traditional blend of teas

Assam 'India'

This Assam has the strength of fruits and spices and provides a real depth of flavour

Darjeeling

The 'Champagne' of teas

Lapsang Souchong

Lapsang leaves are traditionally smoke-dried over pinewood fires, taking on a distinctive smoky flavour

White Tea

White tea is unfermented, picked and served in its natural state.

Snow White 'China'

Refreshing and cool, Snow White delivers a fragrant lingering liquor

Green Tea

Green tea is unfermented, the freshly picked leaves are allowed to dry and are then heated.

Sencha 'Japan'

Light, delicate, perfect for everyday drinking. Sweet and nutty

Gardenia Tea 'Mixed Origin'

A combination of tea, fruit and flower wonderfully balanced

Oolong Tea

Oolong is semi-fermented and means 'Black Dragon'.

The leaves are wilted in the sun and then shaken in bamboo baskets to lightly bruise the edges. The leaves are always whole and never been rolled.

Ali Shan Oolong 'Taiwan'

A lighter roast produces a rich, buttery flavour. Notes of apricot and Mango

Tisanes

Tisanes are infusions of fruits, herbs or dried flowers in boiling water.
They are not a tea in the traditional sense.
