Frequently Asked Questions

What is the scheme?

The 'Eat Out to Help Out' scheme is a government-funded scheme offering 50 per cent off food and non-alcoholic drinks up to the value of £10.00 per person when dining out on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays in August 2020.

Do I require a voucher?

No vouchers are required. The discount will automatically be applied to your bill at the end of your meal.

Are all Club outlets participating?
