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DAVIS

ARTHUR JOSEPH DAVIS

Born in Kensington London in 1878 and studied at the École des Beaux-Arts, Paris in the 1890s. Davis was the interior designer of the London Ritz Hotel and both clubhouses, which introduced modern French comfort and luxury enabled by an innovative steel frame construction. In addition, at Woodcote Park, Mewés and Davis Architects installed modern conveniences, including an air filtration system, radiators and improved kitchen ovens.

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MEWÉS

CHARLES MEWÈS

Born in Alsace in 1858, trained under Jean-Louis Pascal at the École des Beaux-Arts and designer behind both clubhouses, The Ritz London, as well as private residences with Edwardians' opulent taste. The Woodcote Park we know today has a steel frame construction, similar to the one used by Mewés and Davis at Pall Mall.
