MEN'S ELEY 4 BALL



**Old Course, White Tees
Sunday 22 May**

Please [click here](#) for an example scorecard and [click here](#) for the rules of this competition. We advise you print these off prior to play. Please collect your team scorecard from Golf Reception. Eley 4 Ball is played as a Better Ball Against Bogey (Par). Maximum Handicap Index is 18.4.

Handicap: Please play off your playing handicap. This is 90 per cent Course Handicap e.g. Handicap Index 18.4, Course Handicap 22. Playing Handicap 20.

Format: Better Ball Match Play against the course. The card must be scored as match play with a win (+) loss (-) or half (0).

Explanation: Shots are taken at holes indicated by the Stroke Index.

- Play each hole against your own individual net par.
- If you or your partner beat net par, mark the card with the best score and a (+)
- If you or your partner equal net par, mark the card with the best score and a (0)
- If you or your partner cannot achieve a net par mark the card with a (-) and pick up your ball.

Result: This is calculated by deducting the number of holes won (+) from the number of holes lost (-), halved holes are not taken into account.

Important reminder: Remember to record the best score at each hole, in the correct column.

Entry for this competition opens **online** today. This stableford competition is open to passholders with a handicap index up to 24.4.

All Pass Holders must have three Club competitions on their playing record to be eligible to participate in, and win, this Honours Board Competition. If a new member has transferred in from another Club, they must have a full complement of 20 scores on their WHS Handicap Index record or have played in three Club Competitions to be eligible for Honours Board Competitions.

Members who do not qualify using the above criteria may still play in this competition but they will not be charged the applicable entry fee and are not eligible to win the event. The score will, however, count towards the three qualifying rounds required for future eligibility. This Honours Board Competition takes place on the Old Course at **4.30am**.

The entry fee is £11.50 which includes the competition fee and tea or coffee on arrival in the 19th Hole at **4.00am**. This will be followed by a bacon bap which will be available at the Halfway House from **4.30am**.
