Update and Amendment to Preferred Lies

Preferred lies were introduced in July under model local rule E-3 to help address the impacts of prolonged drought and the sporadic regrowth caused by a period of wetter weather.

Whilst the impact of these conditions is still evident across the fairways, there is an obligation under the rules of golf to reduce the size of the relief area as conditions improve.

Effective from Monday 1 September, preferred lies will remain in place; however, when your ball is on closely mown areas, you may mark its position, lift it, clean it and place it within six inches of its original spot, no closer to the hole. This rule applies only to closely mown areas. The local will remain in effect until further notice.

We believe maintaining the option of preferred lies will contribute to a more enjoyable and fair golfing experience for all members. If you have any questions or need further clarification, please do not hesitate to contact the marshals on the course.



Men's Bennett Foursomes


Saturday 27 September

This Honours Board Pairs Competition is played as Foursomes against Bogey (Par). The handicap allowance will be half of the combined Course Handicaps. Online entry for this competition will open on Saturday 30 August. The competition is open to Male Pass Holders with a Handicap Index up to 18.4 at the time of entry.

Pass holders must have played in at least three qualifying Medal and Stableford competitions at the Royal Automobile Club 364 days prior to the date of the competition. If a pass holder has transferred in from another club within the last six months, they must have a full complement of 20 scores on their WHS Handicap Index record.
