

Golf Rules and Etiquette at Woodcote Park

With the popularity of golf at Woodcote Park, it is important to remind Members of the rules and etiquette that apply to the game.

Importantly, these rules help ensure that all Members can enjoy their games in a safe and welcoming environment.

Our Golf Information document provides a comprehensive overview of the rules and etiquette. Please download Golf Information at Woodcote Park.

During the season, the tee times are heavily utilised. This places importance on ensuring the rules of golf are adhered to. The R&A opens the rules of golf with the conduct expected of all players. These provide helpful hints for enjoying your golf at Woodcote Park:

- 1. Acting with integrity: for example by following the rules, applying any associated penalties and being honest in all aspects of play.
- Showing consideration to others: for example by playing at a prompt pace and looking out for the safety of others. If a player hits a ball in a direction where there might be a danger of hitting someone, they should immediately shout a warning such as the traditional warning of 'fore'.

3. Taking good care of the course: for example by replacing divots, smoothing bunkers, repairing ball marks and not causing unnecessary damage to the course.
