# Tea Selection

## *Black Tea*

Earl Grey

*Large leaf black tea with Calabrian bergamot.*

Kenya Black

*A strong, vibrant, lively, old-fashioned black tea.*

Assam 2nd Flush

*A strong rich Assam with the classic Assam malty notes*

Supermuscatel 2nd Flush Darjeeling

(Gopaldhara Garden, Darjeeling)

*A very fine Darjeeling with the famous 'muscatel' grape notes of the 2nd flush season, which are getting harder to find.*

## *Green Tea*

Okumidori Kabusecha 2023

(Nishi Garden, Kyushu - Organic)

*Very high grade of Japanese green tea, grown under the shade to increase the smooth umami flavour. Notes of edamame, long umami finish. Can be served the Japanese way at 40-60°C or to your preference.*

Mountain Green 2023

(Mann Garden, Himachal Pradesh)

*Floral, sappy, delicate green tea from a hidden gem tea region in North India that almost no one knows is making tea.*

## *Oolong Tea*

Kyoto Oolong

(Nakai Garden, Kyoto - Organic)

*Apricot opening, toasty biscuit and pastry notes. Made on a 7th generation family owned tea garden in Kyoto.*

## *Tisane*

Fresh Mint

*Pungent, with refreshingly cool and crisp minty notes.*
