



Bennett Foursomes Competition Rules

Name: Bennett Foursomes is played as Foursomes against Bogey (Par)

Handicap: Allowance is $\frac{1}{2}$ of Combined Course handicap. e.g. Combined 30 Course handicap will be allocated 15 shots.

Format: **Foursomes against Bogey (Par)**. The card must be scored with your gross score with a win (+) loss (-) or half (0).

Explanation: Shots are taken at holes indicated by the Stroke Index.

If, as a pair, you beat net par- mark the card with your gross score and a (+)

If, as a pair, you equal net par- mark the card with your gross score and a (0)

If, as a pair, you *cannot achieve a net par* mark the card with a (-) **and pick up your ball.**

Results: This is calculated by deducting the number of holes won (+) from the number of holes lost (-), (halved holes are not taken into account).

Important reminder: Remember to record your gross score at each hole, in the correct column.

Foursomes: using one ball alternate shots until the ball is holed.

Pairs must maintain alternative tee shots

i.e. Player teeing on odd number holes on front 9 must continue teeing off on odd number holes on back 9
