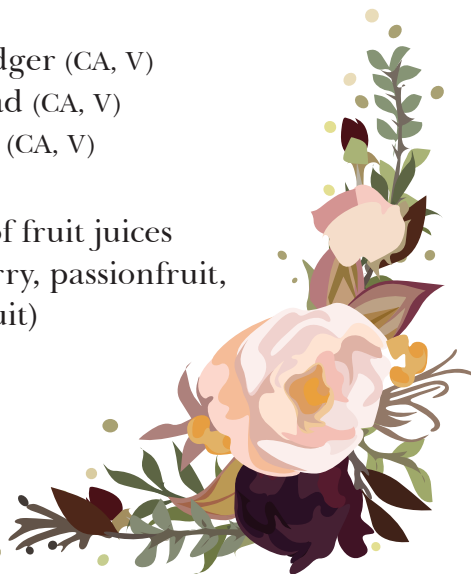

Tea Selection

Sencha Spring Time (Scented Green Tea – Japan)

A marvellous blend of Sencha green tea with natural flavourings from freeze dried strawberry, rosebuds, mallow and sunflower petals.

Temple of Heaven (Gunpowder Green Tea – China)

Hand-rolled leaves resembling gunpowder used by British warships, softer aroma and low bitterness.

Jasmine Pearls Imperial (Green Tea – China)

Soft and velvety, the pearls have a stronger jasmine scent and a superior, more refined taste.

Formosa (Oolong Tea – Taiwan)

Sourced from the Taiwanese Mountains, this tea has a rich complexity, light body with a flowery and spicy taste.

Himalayan Gold and Honey (Black Tea – Nepal)

An award winning rich malty tea, well balanced with a special honey sweetness.

Ceylon Special Ratnapura (Black Tea – Sri Lanka)

Highly aromatic and spicy fine pine needle shaped leaves with silvery tips. Similar to a mild and malty Assam.

English Breakfast, Earl Grey, Darjeeling, Chamomile and Lapsang Souchong Tea are also available in loose leaf.
